Quota will be allocated according to trainer number & trainee intake situation of each training hospital.</i></p> <p><i>After attending the TTT course, sponsored candidates are required to observe Echo A once and then serve as HKCA echo trainers for at least 2 years to help supervise and assess College's Anaesthetic trainees' focused transthoracic echocardiography practices via Electronic Portfolio System.</i></p> <p><i>If candidate leaves HA within 2 years or he/she has not supervised at least 5 times within 2 years, \$8,600 is required to return to HKCA.</i></p>		
Certificate	A certificate will be jointly issued by HKCA and Echo Laboratory of PWH/CUHK upon completion of the course.
