 - 6. Explain what fear avoidance is. Describe the relationship between fear avoidance behaviors and persistent pain.
 - 7. Your patient with chronic low back pain considers having acupuncture for pain management. What advice will you give him?
 - 8. Discuss the role of ion channel abnormalities in pathogenesis of pain.
