- 1. Please describe the fear avoidance model of development of chronic pain.
- 2. a) Define palliative care.
 - b) List the common discomforts / sufferings, apart from pain, in patients suffering from incurable cancer
- 3. Discuss the role of occupational therapy in Complex Regional Pain Syndrome rehabilitation.
- 4. What is breakthrough pain in cancer setting? and how to manage breakthrough pain?
- 5. Management of back pain due to osteoporotic vertebral collapse in an elderly.
- 6. A 45-year-old patient had anterior resection for rectal cancer 2 years ago. He had since developed multiple liver and bone secondaries and takes high dose of opioids regularly for pain relief. He presented with intestinal obstruction that requires laparotomy.
 - a) What are the factors to be considered in devising a plan for management of his post-operative pain? (50%).
 - b) Explain your management strategy for this patient, including the potential complications and management. (50%)

- 7. You are invited to speak to general practitioners about pain management in patients with dementia.
 - a) Briefly outline cognitive examination for cognitive impairment (20%)
 - b) How prevalent is chronic pain in patients with dementia. What type of pain is most common in this group? (10%)
 - c) Describe pain assessment in patients suffering from dementia (30%)
 - d) List examples of non-pharmacological treatments and outline challenges specific to this group of patients (40%)
- 8. Outline the psychosocial assessment of a patient with chronic pain.
- 9. Explain the terms "wind-up" and "central sensitization". What are the significance of these concepts?
